It’s that time of season again! I hate to bring it up – but... our winterizing list has begun. We will drain your water heater, main drains and holding tanks, reinstall the anode rod with thread tape, blow out your water lines and pump in 3 - 4 gallons of RV Anti-Freeze. We will put your boxes on the roof over your windows. Worry free protection for \$75.

We will be winterizing campers on Friday the 13th and Saturday the 14th. None on Sunday as we will be tied up saying our farewells to all of you.
